Pool Safe Rules

An important reminder of Pool Alone Policy and why we have one. As a Pool Safe accredited facility, Recreation Aotearoa, our governing body, require us to follow the Pool Alone Policy. If your child fun swims after their lessons, please ensure the guidelines are followed. A general recap is that all swimmers under the age of 8 require a caregiver who is 16 years or older. Under 5 years/non-swimmers have a ratio of 1 caregiver to every 2 children/non-swimmer and be within arms reach at all times. *Please note a non-swimmer has no age requirements but is based on whether a person has no – limited swimming ability. Ages 5 – 7 years see the ratio of 1 caregiver to every 4 children of this age bracket and must be actively supervising (able to be alert with no distractions and provide immediate assistance).
